I hope this message finds you and your family safe and well. Today, Illinois Governor JB Pritzker announced that remote learning in Illinois will be extended through April 30th in order to slow down the spread of COVID-19.

While it is not ideal, we want to assure you that at Fieldcrest CUSD #6, our staff is fully engaged and willing to take on this new challenge. We will continue forward with remote learning, engaging with students and with our food distribution program.

As a recap, here are the three priorities for our leadership and planning moving forward:

Priority 1 - Feed and care for the extended safety, health, and welfare of students, families, and community at large.

In order to say hello and share waves and smiles with our students, **we'll hold a parade through Minonk, Rutland, Dana, Wenona, and Toluca on Wednesday, April 8th.** There will be no videoconferencing, Zoom meetings, or other meetings during parade times.
