News and Notes

- **High School Update...** Over the weekend, the district made the decision to move the high school to Full Remote Instruction through Thursday, September 24. Students currently attending In Person must be available during regular school hours throughout this Remote Learning Period. This will include sessions with staff and checking in virtually with instructors during each period a student is assigned to the class. Students currently participating in Remote Learning since the start of the school year, may be able to attend sessions with their classes more readily during this time. Please follow up with your teachers regarding this opportunity.

1. The high school will continue to follow the current Block Schedule set up for the 1:00 dismissal. Periods will continue to switch daily from Even Periods to Odd Periods. Teachers will take attendance during each period just as if students were attending in person. Students will be marked present by the instructor as long as they check in through Schoology or are engaged with assignments and/or are participating in Zoom sessions. Students should follow the directives of the teacher during each period as to the procedures for "checking in" for attendance. Another copy of the period schedule is found on page 2 of *Happenings*.
2. Students attending off campus service locations including BACC and CoOperative work locations will continue to participate in In Service instruction. Parents are asked to continue to Self Certify those students each morning in advance of attending those locations. Temperatures will be taken before students leave for BACC. CoOp students should continue to follow the employer guidelines. BACC students must be at the high school on travel days by 11:15 AM to check in so that the bus may depart by 11:25.
3. Students participating in extracurricular "In season" activities will continue to be able to practice and engage in contests during the Full Remote Instruction. Athletes must continue to be self-certified by parents before attending a practice or contest. All scheduled "out of season" contact days will be suspended until In Person Instruction returns. Student athletes should remain in contact with their coaches for specific details.
