• **Vintage Hitchcock: A Live Radio Drama...** Last spring, the Fieldcrest Drama Department was forced to cancel their production for the first time in Fieldcrest history. Over the summer, it became clear a regular show would not be possible this fall, but creativity exists even in adversity. We brainstormed and came up with the idea of performing or creating a radio drama. After meeting with students, we narrowed our selection down to **"Vintage Hitchcock: A Live Radio Drama"** by reading selections of shows aloud. Immediately, the timeless power of a Hitchcock radio play was evident to the students and they embraced the plan. Since Covid restrictions remain in place, a live audience will be impossible, but we wanted to find a way to offer families a chance to view our final product. Talk With College, Career, and Military Representatives During 8th Hour Study


* During 8th Hour Study Halls Senior Students will get a chance to meet with various college, career, and military representatives.

- Your 2019 federal tax returns, W-2's, and other records of money earned
- Banking statements and records of investments (if applicable)
- Records of untaxed income (if applicable)
- List of colleges you would like to attend

Additional information you will need if you are completing the FAFSA:

- Social Security Number. Be sure it is correct!
- Your Alien Registration Number, if you (student) are not a U.S. citizen
- An FSA ID to sign electronically
